WEEKLY NOTES:**The Good vs. Heritage**

When the final whistle blew last Friday, the Bobcats found themselves on the wrong side of the scorecard, falling 35-11 to the Patriots, and extending their losing streak to the Patriots to three straight years. Even in the loss, though, there were several bright spots, and things to build on for the season. Bobcat Quarterback and "pinball wizard" **Vinny Ward (Sr.)** and Running Back **Zion Knight (Sr.)** ran roughshod over the Patriots Defense. Ward's 176 yards on 21 touches (including a Touchdown, Two Point Conversion, and a long-run of 26 yards) combined with Knight's 85 yards on 15 touches (including a long-run of 27 yards) led the way to the most team rushing yards in a single game for the Bobcats since a 43-42 overtime win against Heritage in 2019. **Montrece Bennett (So.)** picked off Heritage Quarterback Xavier Murray, hauled in two passes offensively, along with being a bright spot in the return game - ending the night with 86 All Purpose Yards. On Special Teams, Bobcat Kicker **Caleb Gay (Sr.)** kicked the Bobcats' first successful field goal since the 2023 season, and Bennett had several big returns for the Bobcats.

The Bad vs. Heritage

The Bobcats struggled, particularly early in the game, to hang on to the football, fumbling on the opening kickoff, and twice more in the first half. Those fumbles were difficult for the defense to overcome. Additionally, the Bobcats turned the ball over on downs multiple times when they had drives into Heritage Territory but could not cash in, including a drive that made its way inside the Patriot 10 yard line.

The Ugly vs. Heritage

Quite simply: the final scoreboard. The Bobcats simply must find a way to finish drives and put points on the board, especially once the grind of the Region Schedule arrives.

Return of "The Shield"

A fixture at midfield for more than 20 years, after a brief hiatus, the Bobcat Football Crest made its way back to Bobcat Field last week for the season opener. A true work of art, the shield is hand laid-out and painted, and there are no stencils or robots used to paint it. The brain-child of former Head Coach **Kirk Williams**, the outline of the shield is first carefully laid out by long-time Greenbrier High School Official Statistician and jack-of-all-trades (most notably these days his BBQ), **Jeff White**. Once

the outline has been created, Jeff uses only a piece of string and some stakes to "draw" the Old English "G" that is featured prominently in the middle of the Crest. Once all the outline has been created, Coach Williams hand paints the nearly 4 foot tall BOBCATS letters across the top banner, the flags off the sides, and shading, again all measured by feel and all done free-hand. Lastly, everything is hand sprayed and filled. The entire project takes between 6-10 gallons of paint weekly.

A Look Ahead

The Bobcats now turn their attention to another 3A opponent in the Sycamore War Eagles. The football series with Sycamore, particularly in the early 2000's featured some of the most iconic games in Bobcat Football history. Both games in 2003 (one in the regular season and one in the playoffs) were decided by incredible goal-line stands by the Bobcats, and produced iconic calls from the Bobcats Radio's then Color Analyst Ricky Green.

Sycamore also enters the game under a first-year Head Coach in Andrew Gerhardstein. Gerhardstein coached most recently at Cocke County High School in Newport, TN, where he served as the Defensive Coordinator. Previous stops include Heritage High School in Maryville and multiple spots in Illinois. He was also played four years as a Defensive Lineman in Aurora, Illinois.

A Trip Around Region 6-4A

Because the TSSAA began setting Region schedules a few years back, no Region Games will take place for several weeks, but all Region Teams were in action on Friday Night. **Liberty Creek** took a trip to Robertson County to take on **East Robertson**. The Wolves led much of the game, but East was able to pull even late, and eventually take the win in Overtime. **White House** opened the season playing host to **Portland** and it was the Panthers, under new head coach Bryan Dupree, who came out on top in that contest. **Pearl Cohn**, who is playing maybe the most difficult early schedule of any Division I team, fell to MBA 20-34, and will take on CPA this week. **Springfield** was the only team in the region with a Week 1 win, handling their business over Rossvue 35-3.

This Week's Games on Tap

In addition to the matchup between the Bobcats and the War Eagles, Heritage will travel to Kenwood, Macon County will host Westmoreland, Whites Creek will host Trousdale County, Portland hosts Liberty Creek, White House hosts DeKalb County, Pearl Cohn will host CPA, Springfield will travel to Clarksville, and West Creek will travel to Clarksville Northeast.

Coach Spotlight - Head Coach Aaron Pitts

Coach Pitts is no stranger to success. As a prep athlete, Coach Pitts was an All-State nominee, and still holds the school record for longest interception return for a touchdown (108 yards). Following high school and a Junior College stint, Coach Pitts found his way to Murfreesboro, Tennessee, as a member of the Blue Raider Football Team, where he was active in the defensive backfield. Following graduation from MTSU, Coach Pitts began his coaching career. His stops include as an assistant coach at Marshall County where most notably he was a coach for University of Alabama and NFL stand-out Dont'a Hightower. Coach Pitts later took on the Head Coach job at Marshall County. After taking some time off with a young and growing family, Coach Pitts picked back up coaching, with stops including Offensive Coordinator for a State Championship Runner-Up run at Cornersville. He has twice been named Region Assistant Coach of the Year, and comes to the Bobcats after serving as Offensive Coordinator at LaVergne High School.

New Broadcast Debut

Ever the consummate professional, Greenbrier High School Junior and prominent member of the Bobcats Basketball Squad **Jacek McClellan** made his Broadcast Debut Friday night, joining **Radio Voice of the Bobcats Jim Sorrells** at halftime and joining as impromptu Color Analyst for the second half. Jacek did an excellent job, and has grown with his announcing and broadcast skills in recent years. Jacek has become the Voice of Greenbrier Middle School Basketball, has filled in as PA Announcer for Greenbrier High School Baseball, and has announced several Diamond Youth Baseball Tournaments. Jacek will be in the booth more often this fall, as he will be announcing some Greenbrier Middle School, Greenbrier Junior Pro, and Greenbrier High School JV and Freshman Games in addition to an expanded role on broadcasts, especially for home games.
