WEEKLY NOTES:**The Good vs. Sycamore**

The Bobcats running game was on again Friday night, especially early. By the time the horn blew to end the first quarter, the Bobcats had already eclipsed 100 yards rushing, and would continue to pile up the numbers as the game went on. Quarterback **Vinny Ward** finished the night with 66 rushing yards, while **Zion Knight** led the way rushing with 89. **Montrece Bennett** hauled in three passes for 50 yards and a touchdown, and added another 51 kickoff return yards to combine for 101 all purpose yards for the game.

The Bad vs. Sycamore

The Bobcats struggled to capitalize and put points on the board, especially late in the game. Several drives stalled out due to untimely penalties and near misses in the passing game. Ultimately, the Bobcats were unable to overcome the sputters offensively to put points on the board in a way they had hoped.

The Ugly vs. Sycamore

Chunk plays. A rewatch of the film (and a look at the stat sheet) shows a much closer game than the scoreboard would indicate. Sycamore was able to convert multiple times on third and long with desperation passes that were hauled in by War Eagle receivers. In short - the Bobcats have to find a way to slow down opponents' passing game.

Return of "The Shield"

A fixture at midfield for more than 20 years, after a brief hiatus, the Bobcat Football Crest made its way back to Bobcat Field last week for the season opener. A true work of art, the shield is hand laid-out and painted, and there are no stencils or robots used to paint it. The brain-child of former Head Coach **Kirk Williams**, the outline of the shield is first carefully laid out by long-time Greenbrier High School Official Statistician and jack-of-all-trades (most notably these days his BBQ), **Jeff White**. Once the outline has been created, Jeff uses only a piece of string and some stakes to "draw" the Old English "G" that is featured prominently in the middle of the Crest. Once all the outline has been created, Coach Williams hand paints the nearly 4 foot tall BOBCATS letters across the top banner, the flags off the sides, and shading, again all measured by feel and all done free-

hand. Lastly, everything is hand sprayed and filled. The entire project takes between 6-10 gallons of paint weekly.

A Look Ahead

The Bobcats now turn their attention to a foe that is very familiar (though the series has been on ice - and last year underwater) for more than a decade.

Greenbrier and Macon County played every year between 1979 and 2000, with a brief pause from 2001-2004, and a pickup of the rivalry from 2005 - 2014. The Bobcats and Tigers were slated to renew the rivalry last season, but the game had just gotten started when storms rolled in and canceled the evening. The teams decided not to complete the game, which went into the record books as a 7-0 victory for the Tigers.

Macon County has been on quite the run of late, including a 2024 Class 4A State Championship. Through two games so far this season, the stingy Tigers defense has allowed only twelve points, while the offense is averaging more than 30 points per game.

A Trip Around Region 6-4A

Liberty Creek went just down the road to take on **Portland**, and the Wolves put on a scoring clinic, with the score at the final whistle of 41-0. **White House** scored 21 points for the second week in a row, but also for a second week in a row, 21 was not enough, as the Blue Devils fell to **DeKalb County** 21-23. **Pearl Cohn** continued their early season gauntlet, picking up a big win against CPA, winning that contest 18-13. Pearl will continue their alphabet soup schedule taking on BGA Friday night. **Springfield** continued their winning ways, with a big win over rival **Clarksville High School**, winning 35-17.

This Week's Games on Tap

In addition to the matchup between the Bobcats and the Tigers, Heritage hosts Richland, Sycamore will make the trip to Sumner County to take on Liberty Creek. Whites Creek is scheduled to play Mt. Juliet Christian Academy - MJCA was forced to forfeit its first scheduled game of the season scheduled against Jo Byrns as the Saints did not have enough players healthy. Portland's life does not get any easier

as the Panthers make the trip to Springfield, and White House will make the short drive in-county to take on Station Camp. Pearl Cohn will travel to BGA, and West Creek will host Antioch.

Coach Spotlight - Assistant Head Coach / Offensive Line Coach / Technology Coordinator Luke White

Coach White has been around Greenbrier Football since birth. A 2003 graduate of Greenbrier High School, and Varsity Football Letterman, Coach White was the placekicker for the Bobcats and part of a class that was instrumental in helping begin turning the tide in the early 2000's to prepare the way for one of the greatest runs in Greenbrier Football History. Following graduation, Coach White attended Tennessee Technological University, and after graduation returned home to Greenbrier to teach and coach. 2026 is Coach White's 19th Season as an Assistant Coach for the Bobcats.

Another New Broadcast Debut

Another week, and another addition to the Bobcat Radio Network broadcast team. After welcoming Greenbrier High School Junior Jacek McClellan to the fold last week, Greenbrier High School Business teacher and Assistant Baseball Coach Tyler Cates made his broadcast debut on color commentary during the second half of the Sycamore Game. Following the broadcast, it was decided that Tyler will join the broadcast team full-time as color commentator for the remainder of the games on the 2026 Football Slate. The move, along with the addition of Jacek McClellan will elevate the broadcasts with a steady broadcast team (up to this point, it was essentially a one-man show for home games as Kevin handled PA duties).
